## **Registration Fees, Refund, and Medical Fitness Policy**

### **1. Organizing Entity**

The **Greek Orthodox Archdiocesan District Olympics Committee** (the “Organization”) is a nonprofit organization recognized as tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is the organizer and administrator of the **Greek Orthodox Archdiocesan District Olympics** (the “Event”). Registration for the Event opens on **February 15 2026**.

### **2. Acceptance of Terms**

By completing registration and submitting payment, each participant, or the participant’s parent or legal guardian if the participant is a minor, acknowledges, understands, and agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in this policy.

### **3. Registration Fees and Payment Terms**

All registration fees are **final and non-refundable**, regardless of registration period, status, or reason for withdrawal.

Each registration is subject to:

- **A non-refundable processing fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00);** and
- **All credit card, electronic payment, and third-party payment processing fees**, which are also **non-refundable**.

Under no circumstances shall registration fees, processing fees, or payment processing fees be refunded, transferred, deferred, or credited, including but not limited to situations involving injury, illness, medical conditions, scheduling conflicts, weather, travel issues, or inability to attend or participate.

### **4. Refund Policy**

**No refunds shall be issued under any circumstances**, including for registrations completed during Early Registration, Regular Registration, or Late Registration periods.

In the event the Organization cancels or materially modifies the Event, the Organization’s liability, if any, shall be limited to the extent required by applicable law.

### **5. Medical Fitness and Assumption of Risk**

The Event involves physically demanding athletic activities. Each participant certifies that they are medically, physically, and mentally fit to safely participate.

Participants, or their parent or legal guardian, acknowledge and agree that:

- They are solely responsible for determining fitness for participation;
- The Organization does not provide medical screening, diagnosis, or clearance;
- Consultation with a licensed medical professional prior to participation is strongly recommended.

Participation is undertaken **at the participant’s own risk**. Medical conditions, injuries, illnesses, disabilities, or medical advice to refrain from participation **do not constitute grounds for a refund**.

### **6. Participation Eligibility and Safety**

The Organization reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to deny, restrict, or revoke participation at any time if it determines that participation may pose a risk to the participant or others, or is inconsistent with Event rules, safety requirements, or the mission of the Organization.

### **7. Modifications and Enforcement**

The Organization reserves the right to amend or modify this policy at any time. Continued participation in the Event constitutes acceptance of any such modifications.

### **8. Governing Law**

This policy shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the applicable jurisdiction, without regard to conflict-of-law principles.
